



Panelists are **Dr. Elena Gates**, a UCSF obstetrician and gynecologist with a special interest in medical ethics relating to women's health care and reproduction; **Dr. Paolo Rinaudo**, a specialist in reproductive endocrinology and fertility at the UCSF Center for Reproductive Health who conducts research on pre-implantation embryo development and the long-term consequences of in vitro culture; and **Nolwenn Bühler**, an anthropologist specialized in gender and science and technology studies currently a visiting researcher at UC Berkeley.

Moderator **Kirsten Sanford** ("Dr. Kiki"), one of the top science media personalities in the nation, will lead the

discussion touching on subjects including genetic selection, in vitro fertilization, transformed family structures, and the financial, medical, and psychological aspects of new reproductive opportunities.
